- This is the most modern and ‘in line with the rest of the industry’ version of Drupal ever
- Energy around more sophisticated content management tools & front-end techniques is amazing
- Drupal is being adopted & supported at all levels of the industry



DriesNote

- Great look at where Drupal is going
- D8: 3000+ contributors (3x increase from D7)
- 75% of survey response centered on content authors & site builders
- In use in larger & larger enterprises & varying applications (MTA kiosks, Lufthansa inflight entertainment system, Tesla apps)
